Ethics is part of daily life, and arises frequently in community health care. In making ethical decisions, health care providers and organizations must balance individual and collective values with professional responsibilities, taking into account the interests of many stakeholders. This workshop will review how to use an ethics framework to work through ethical decisions, applying it to a case study in the community. In facing ethical uncertainty, the use of an ethics framework provides a fair process to determine, not only what to do, but how to enact a decision.
