Waitlists are commonly used tools to deliver various services across the healthcare spectrum where there is more demand than the system can meet in a timely way. The purpose and the design of waitlists may seem reasonable at a first glance. Still, their existence may complicate access to care for some people. In this session, the creation and management of the waitlists—including criteria for prioritizing care will be examined using an ethical lense. Existing examples of waitlists will be discussed, and some practical considerations for guiding how to use waitlists fairly and equitably will be shared with the audience.
