

In June 2016 Medical Assistance in Dying became a legal option for eligible patients at end of life. Since then changes to the criminal code opened eligibility for persons whose death is not reasonably foreseeable. This presentation will provide an overview of the eligibility criteria and legal safeguards for Medical Assistance in Dying in Canada today, briefly look at what's to come in relation to eligibility and patient demographics expected in the next few years and explore the roles and responsibilities of health care providers at various stages of MAiD care.
