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## Don't Shy Away: A Relational Ethics Approach to Understanding the MAiD Legacy and Experience with Health Care Providers through Narrative Analysis of Bereaved Family

MAiD now accounts for >3% of annual Canadian deaths, highlighting the importance of the relationship between MAiD-involved families and those providing care. Increases in MAiD patients necessitates consideration for the role of healthcare providers in the support of MAiD-involved family. Findings suggest that several features of clinician interactions with the family can have beneficial or adverse outcomes. Relational ethics is a framework that can be used to inform healthcare practice.
